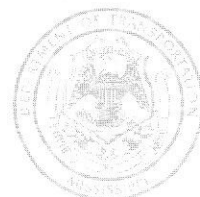

You must inform the certifying entity's DBE Program in writing of any change in circumstances affecting your company's ability to meet size, disadvantaged status, ownership or control requirements or any material changes in the information provided in your certification application. **You must provide written notification within 30 days of the occurrence of the change.** If you fail to make timely notification of change, you will be deemed to have failed to cooperate under Section 26.109 (c). If you are an out-of-state firm and lose your certification in your home state, you will be removed from the Mississippi UCP DBE Certification list as well.

The Mississippi UCP certifying entity reserves the right to withdraw this certification if at any time it is determined your certification was knowingly obtained by false, misleading will, or incorrect information. The Mississippi UCP certifying entity also reserves the right to request additional information and/or conduct an on site visit at any time during the certification period to verify any documentation submitted in the application for certification. By accepting certification your firm hereby consents to the examination of its books and documents by the certifying entity's DBE Program.
